

The Grace Hudowalski Essay Contest

2nd Annual Contest
February 1st - April 28, 2008

(Ages 11-14)

PURPOSE: To increase the knowledge and awareness of the history and environmental issues in and around the Towns of Schroon and North Hudson.

TOPIC CATEGORIES: Entries must address either the history or environmental concerns of the Adirondacks

AGE CATEGORY: Authors must be between the ages of 11 and 14 by the end of the 2007-2008 School Year.

AWARDS: A three-week campership to POKO-Moonshine/Poko-MacCready will be awarded for the best overall essay in either category. A \$100 Savings Bond will be awarded for the runner-up essay in either category.

JUDGING: Judges will be chosen from the Adirondack 46r Trust and the Schroon-North Hudson Historical Society. Each essay will be read by at least three judges.

Essays will be judged on:

1. Application to the area, interesting discussion and choice of examples
2. Originality of presentation
3. Readability and appeal
4. Proper English construction

REQUIREMENTS:

Authors must reside in, associate or attend school within the Towns of Schroon or North Hudson. Essays must be of a qualified length to adequately describe the historical or environmental issues chosen.

A bibliography must be included.

All essays must be typewritten or computer generated, double-spaced on 8 ½ x 11 white paper, one side only.

Cover sheet should include name, age, address, phone number, school, school address and essay category.

Essays become the property of the Schroon-North Hudson Historical Society and will not be returned.
